PQDIF Viewer is a free utility app published by Russ Patterson. It is provided as-is and at no cost. This policy explains what information the app handles when you use it. Contact support@pqdif-viewer.org with any questions related to this policy.

Summary

PQDIF Viewer does not collect, transmit, store, or share any personal information. The app runs entirely on your device. The PQDIF (.pqd) files you open stay on your device unless you send them to support@pqdif-viewer.org.

Information Collection and Use

PQDIF Viewer does not collect any personal information. It does not require an account, does not use analytics or tracking, and does not transmit usage data.

The app loads the JSZip JavaScript library from a public content delivery network (cdnjs.cloudflare.com) at launch. This is a standard library download and does not transmit any data about you.

Diagnostic Information

PQDIF Viewer includes an in-app diagnostic log that captures parser messages and error details from your current session. This log stays on your device unless you choose to share it.

The "Email Support" feature in the app lets you attach the currently-loaded .pqd file and the recent diagnostic log to an email addressed to support@pqdif-viewer.org. This email is composed by you, in your device's mail app, and is only sent if you choose to send it. No information is transmitted automatically.

Files You Open

Files you open in PQDIF Viewer are read on your device for the purpose of plotting their contents. They are not uploaded, shared, or transmitted unless you send them to support@pqdif-viewer.org.

Cookies and Tracking

PQDIF Viewer does not use cookies or tracking technologies.

Children's Privacy

PQDIF Viewer does not collect any information from anyone, including children under 13. The app is intended for use by engineering professionals working with IEEE 1159.3 power quality data records.
